

Intelligence Marrative Day Constion No. E, 1 May 1943.

Twenty 8-26's of the 320th Sembardment Group (#) took off this afternoon on a sea sweep. They were escorted by sixteen P-38's of the 82nd Fighter Group. Two 8-26's (s) returned early.

B-26's did not land at this base. One of these landed at Bone, one near Bone, and one is unreported.

Route: As ordered to point within sight of Western tip of Sicily, varying to avoid rain squalls, and return to base.

Chronology: Sembers took off between 13:50 hours and 13:58 hours, reached a point within sight of Sicily at 15:42 hours. Fifteen bombers down at this base between 17:20 hours and 17:33 hours.

Bombe: 108 x 500 lb. Demolition, 1/10, .025 sec. delay; fifteen planes returned 90 bombs to this base.

Results: No shipping seen during entire sweep, due in part to poor visibility.

Plak: None.

Heather: From base to essteard point of sweep; 3/10 to 4/10 u. at 10,000 feet to 11,000 feet; visibility 7 miles. Increasing cloudiness at 10,000 feet, becoming 7/10 to 9/10 Gu.; 4/10 tu. at 2,500 feet; tops 4,000 feet. Scattered rainshowers, front West of Bons. Low cloudiness and showers to West. Meturn to base, increasing low cloudiness, 5/10 to 7/10 Gu. at 2,500 feet at 17:00 hours. Heavy showers at this base.

Charryations None.

Comments: The pilot of the unreported plane is Lt. Osborns.
