Intelligence Narrative No. 27. Day Operation 1 June 1943.

Eighteen B-26's of the 320th Bombardment Group (M) took off this afternoon to bomb shipping in Porto Ponte Romano. They were escorted by P-38's of the 14th Fighter Group. One B-26 turned back prior to bombing because of mechanical difficulty; crash landed at Bone. One large M/V was docked at the east side of the pier. No direct hits, three near misses scored on the vessel. Seventeen B-26's returned safely to this base.

Route: 333° T for 78 miles to rendezvous at C. De Fer; 14° T for 149 miles to $39^{\circ} 10' N, 7^{\circ} 50' E$; sweeping turn (35 miles) to the right; bomb run 153° T; 191° T for 205 miles direct from this base.

Bombs: 54 x 1,000-lb. Demolition bombs, 1/10, .025 sec. delay fuse, carried by 18 B-26's. 3 x 1,000-lb. Demolition bombs jettisoned in sea or down at Bone, in plane which crash landed there. (Facts not known at Notch at time of this report.)

Chronology: Time off between 14:13 and 14:22. On course 14:38, rendezvous 15:00, target 15:52, down at base between 16:51 and 17:03/30.

Results: Direct hits on customhouse and road on NW causeway. Three near misses on large M/V docked E. of pier.

Flak: Slight inaccurate heavy flak encountered over target from positions as briefed. In addition, three gun positions were noted today in RR yards SE of Palmas Sueraia.

Observations: 1 large and 3 medium M/V, 30 small boats in Carloforte harbor, at 15:40 from 10,500. The largest M/V was at end of middle pier.

One to two miles E. of Palmas Sueraia RR junction and North of Tratalias, crews report 100 buildings, some red-roofed, whose general appearance suggest a military camp or installations. They are grouped in 4 general subdivisions of approximately 25 buildings each, in form of a square. Time 15:51, from 10,200. Attempt at picture was unsuccessful.

Weather: CAVU.

Our Losses: The plane which crash-landed at Bone is a total loss.

Comments: The town called "Palmas Sueraia" on T.C. 1-118-NA is named "S. Giovanni" on T.C. 1-106-NA.
