

Intelligence Narrative No. 34, Day Operation 11 June 1943.

Twenty-three B-26's of the 320th Bombardment Group took off this afternoon to bomb Lampedusa.

Original plans called for 150 mile course 90° T to GP, but bad weather encountered at the coast forced the formation to encircle the front, passing to the north, crossing the coast at Cape Bon.

One B-26 left the formation and landed at the Salzman A/D, reason unknown.

The weather closed in, and at 1545 there was an 8/10 coverage at 7000', and scattered showers limited the visibility to 8 miles.

The formation returned to this base by 1657.
