

HEADCHARTNES TROTH HOMBANDMENT GROUP (II) Office of the Group Intelligence Officer APO 520

Intelligence Magrative No. 85, Day Operation, 24 September, 1943

Twenty 5-26's of the 320th Hombardment Group (a) took off this morning to bomb the bridge south of Amorosi, Italy. They were unescorted. Two B-26's returned early. I because a generator was out and I was a spare.

The target was bombed successfully. Eighteen 3-26's returned to this base.

Montes and Altitudes: To target: From 2,500° at this base 30° T for 325 statute miles to Palmerola Island: 670 T for 83 statute miles: curve right to IP. 410 170 M. 140 200 E. elimbing gradually to 10,000 ; bomb run, 1320 T for 11 statute miles; brenkaway right.

From target: Curve right, curve left for 70 statute miles to Ventotene island, 2160 T for 332 statute miles to this base, dropping gradually to 3,0001.

number 120 x 500 lb desolition bombs, instantaneous and .025 second delay fuse, carried by 20 %-26's.

12 x 500 lb demolition bombs returned to this base by 2 8-26's that returned early.

108 x 500-1b, demolition bombs dropped over the target area.

thronology: Time off between 0965 and 0955; on course 1005; terget 1158; down at this base between 1415 and 1435.

Seculte: The books started at the south end of the bridge and continued on to the road on course beyond, Probable hits or near misses were scored on the south end of the bridge.

Flaks Slight heavy inacqueste flak was encountered before the target on the bomb run, and miderate to intense heavy accurate flak was encountered from Deresseno and continuing to Sparenise after the breaksney from the target. Heavy gum positions were reported at the following points:

1) A gime at the bend of the river at 410 08' H, 140 25' E.

2) 7 guns at the bend of the river at 410 09 M. H. OS E. (Also several guns between Giaixto and St. Angelo in Formie)

3) A gume at Al 07' H, 14" 15' h, along the river.

A) 5 gume at Al 07' H, 14" 13' A, at the bend of the river.

5) 7 gume at Al 05' H, 14 11' E.


