Intelligence Narrative No. 149, Day Operation 12 February 1944.

Flight Commander: Major Marble.

A. 320th Bombardment Group (M).

B. At 1125 hours, 36 B-26's of the 320th Bombardment Group (M) took off to bomb Troop Concentrations at Ariccia, Italy. They were unescorted. 1 B-26 returned early due to nose wheel malfunction. No bombs were dropped and the formation was forced to turn back at 1235 hours at 16,000' because of weather. The point reached was $38^{\circ} 44' N$, $10^{\circ} 17' E$, where the temperature was 35° below at 16,000'. 35 B-26's returned to this base at 1314 hours.

4. Weather: Enroute: Broken low clouds, 100 miles out, cumulonimbus base 3 to 4,000', tops 20,000'.

Target: Not reached.

E. ROUTES AND ALTITUDES: From this base at 2,500', to the southeast coast of Sardinia, then to $38^{\circ} 44' N$, $10^{\circ} 17' E$, climbing gradually to 16,000'; reciprocal course homeward, descending to 2,500' at this base.
