Intelligence Narrative No. 157, Day Operation, 22 Feb. 1944.

Flight Commander: Captain Graves.

- A. 320th Bombardment Group (M).
- B. At 1212 hours, 28 B-26's of the 320th Bombardment Group (M) took off to bomb Montalto di Castre RR Bridge, Italy. They were unescorted. 1 B-26 returned early because of engine trouble. 27 B-26's were over the target, and 24 B-26's dropped 96 x 1000 lb demolition bombs (1/2, inst. and .025 second delay fuses; 1/2, 1/10, .025 second delay fuses) on the target at 1358 hours from 9,100 to 10,300'. 4 x 1000 lb demolition bombs were salvoed in the target area because of intervalometer failure. 8 x 1000 lb demolition bombs were returned to this base, 4 because A/C was not in a position to drop because of cloud cover and 4 because A/C's leader did not drop. 27 B-26's returned safely and undamaged at 1543 hours.
- C. RESULTS: Bombs of half the formation bracketed the target with an excellent pattern of bombs, scoring 3 direct hits on the bridge, 2 on the south approach and one on the tracks north of the bridge. Bombs of the other A/C were wide but cut the read north of the target.

D. OBSERVATIONS:

l. Air:

a. Air Activity: None.

b. Situation: Tarquinia A/D was empty of A/C, but appeared to have been repaired at 1259 hours from 10,000'.

2. Ground:

a. General: None.

b. Communications: 30/40 RR cars (one crew member reported counting 80/90 through field glasses) were seen at Montalto di Castro M/Y at 1358 from 10,000° c. Flak: None.

d. Shipping: 1. Large boat previously observed beached off Montalto di Castro was still there, with 2 barges reported also beached near it at 1402 hours from 10,000'.

2. 2 small boats headed SW were seen off Tarquinia at 1403

hours from 10,000'.

3. 3 med. M/Y were seen in Civitavecchia harbor at 1404

hours from 9,500'.

Losses: No A/C lost or damaged.

4. Weather: a. Enroute, 5/10 cumulus, 3,000'to 6/7000', visibility 8 miles in haze.

b. Target, 6-8/10 cumulus, 3,000 - 8,000', visibility

8 miles in haze.

c. Return, cumulus had increased to 8/10, tops 11,000'.

- E. ROUTHE AND ALTITUDES: From 2,500' at base, 30° T for 236 statute miles to Pt. Tre. Ciana climbing gradually to 10,500'; 96° M to target, at 9,700', breakaway right to coast at A 0610; 215° T for 246 statute miles to base, dropping gradually to 2,500'.
- F. COMMENTS: Cloud cover prevented the first half of the fermation from securing an adequate run on the target.
