Intelligence Narrative No. 189, Day Operations, 22 April 1944

Flight Commanders: Lt. Col. Fletcher, Major Macia, Capt. Saylor.

A. 320th Bombardment Group (M).

B: At 0836 hours, 54 B-26's of this Group took off to bomb Bucine Viaduct North, Rignano RR Bridge and Incisa R^K Bridge, Italy. They were escorted by Spitfires from Corsica. 6 spares returned early. Poggibonsi South was bombed instead of Bucine because the a/c were not in a position to drop. Poggibonsi North was bombed instead of Rignano because the a/c were not in a position to drop and due to bombardier error. 48 a/c were over the targets. 13 a/c dropped 52 x 1000 lb. demo bombs (.1 - .025 second delay fuses) on Poggibonsi South; 15 a/c dropped 60 x 1000 lb. demos (.1 - .025 second delay fuses) on Poggibonsi North; 13 a/c dropped 52 x 1000 lb. demo bombs (.1 - .025 second delay fuses) on Incisa at 1130 to 1150 hours from 9,400 to 8,400'. 28 x 1000 lb. demos were salvaged because a/c were not in position to drop and due to emergencies. No bombs were returned to base. 21 a/c returned at 1330 hours; 1 a/c damaged by flak crashlanded at Corsica and was destroyed; 20 a/c returned by 1200 hours on 23 April, 1944 having landed at Corsica to refuel. 6 a/c damaged by flak remained at Corsica.

C. Results: Poggibonsi South and North were missed.

The Bridge at Incisa was not hit.

A large concentration of bombs fell Northwest of Incisa and one string of bombs landed near the southern approach to the RR Bridge. The tunnel on the north approach to the bridge appears to have received a direct hit possibly blocking the line.

D. Observations:

1. Air:

a. Air Activity: 6/10 Spitfires were seen escorting the formation.

b. Situation: 2 S/E a/c at Siena, 1 S/E a/c at Arezzo and 1 S/E a/c south of Cecina were seen at 1130 to 1145 hours from 9,000'.

2. Ground:

a. General:

(1) A factory with several small houses and a large explosion thereat, just south of Cecina was seen at 1100 hours from 9,000'.

(2) Repairs at Bucine south were seen to be in process at 1140 hours from 9,000'.

b. Communications:

(1) 35/45 RR cars were seen at Incisa at 1120 hours from 9,000'.

(2) 30/40 RR cars were seen at Borgo San Lorenzo at 1140 hours from 9000

(3) 1 train of 40 cars was seen north of Prato, heading south and stopping at 1130 hours from 9,000'.

(4) 30/40 RR cars were seen at Riparbella at 1145 hours from 9,000'.

(5) 8/10 RR cars were seen at Certaldo at 1145 hours from 9,000'.

(6) 35 M/T, possibly tanks, were seen at Voltura at 1145 hours from 9,000'.

- (7) 100/125 RR Cars, $\frac{1}{2}$ of them oil cars, were seen at Siena at 1115 hours from 9,000'.
- (8) 50 RR cars were seen at Castiglion Fiorentino at 1145 hours from 9,000'.
- (9) 75/100 RR cars were seen at Cecina and North of it at 1145 hours from 9,000'.
- (10) 15 RR cars were seen at Vernio at 1145 hours from 9,000'.
- (11) 25/35 M/T were seen at San Casciano at 1145 hours from 9,000'.
- (12) 150 RR cars were seen at Arezzo at 1145 hours from 9,000'.
- (13) 40 RR cars were seen at Sesto Fiorentino at 1145 hours from 9,000'.
- (14) 25 RR cars were seen at Rapalano at 1145 hours from 9,000'.
- (15) 45 M/T were seen at San Pietro at 1145 hours from 9,000'.
- (16) 50 RR cars were seen at Prato at 1145 hours from 9,000'.

c. Flak:

- (1) At Bucine from 9,000' - intense heavy, accurate for altitude and deflection CP, 4/8 red flashes were observed just north of Bucine and the flak bursts seemed very large.
- (2) At Rignano from 9,000' - moderate heavy, fairly accurate for altitude and deflection, CP flak; 2 heavy guns were seen firing about 2 miles east of Rignano.
- (3) At Prato from 9,000' - meager heavy, fairly accurate for altitude and deflection, CP flak was observed.
- (4) At Pontassieve flak was observed directed at another squadron.
- (5) At Arezzo from 9,000' - moderate to intense heavy, accurate, CP flak from A/D vicinity.
- (6) At Florence from 9,000' - from a factory area 5 miles north of the city, meager heavy, inaccurate CP flak.

d. Shipping:

- (1) 1 small boat headed north fast was seen north of Cecina 4/5 miles off coast at 1120 hours from 9,000'.
- (2) 2 large M/V anchored and 2 small boats headed north were seen off Castiglioncello at 1120 hours from 9,000'.
- (3) 2 large M/V and 10/12 small boats were seen anchored at Porto Ferraro at 1115 hours from 9,000'.
- (4) 1 PT-boat headed southeast was seen southwest of Elba at 1115 hours from 9,000'.
- (5) 3 medium M/V anchored at Piombino were seen at 1120 hours from 9000'.
- (6) 1 large M/V and 4 small boats anchored off Cecina were seen at 1120 hours from 9,000'.

3. Losses: 1 a/c damaged by flak crashlanded and was destroyed; 1 a/c were damaged by flak and 2 a/c were slightly damaged by flak; 1 airman was killed due to flak and 15 airmen were injured due to flak.

4. Weather: Enroute: Low overcast and rain off east Sardinia, 10 broken over Corsica, high clouds only - Corsica to Italy.

Target: Clear.
Return: No change.

E. Routes and Altitudes: From base to Alto to Cecina Marina to Volte
1st Sqdn. to Siena to Bucine to Poggibonsi South on axis of 90° M, break
left; 2nd Sqdn. to Pergive to Lere Ciuffena to Rignano to Poggibonsi
North on axis of 185° M, break right; 3rd Sqdn. to San Casciano to Inc
on axis of 55° M, break right; to Cecina to base.
