

Intelligence Narrative No. 212, Day Operation, 19 May 1944.

Flight Commander: Colonel Fletcher and Lt. Col. Macia.

A. 320th Bombardment Group (M).

B. At 0805 hours, 54 B-26's of the 320th Bombardment Group (M) took off to bomb Vado RR Viaduct and Grizzana South RR Viaduct, Italy. 6 B-26's returned early: 4 spares; 1 excessive engine temperature; 1 fuel tank leak. 21 B-26's were over Vado Viaduct and 21 dropped 44 x 1000 lb demolition bombs (1/10, .025 second delay fuses) and 80 x 500 lb demolition bombs (1/10, .025 second delay fuses) on the target at 1041 hours from 9,200' to 8,500' on an axis of 335° T. Due to improper target identification, the first squadron of the second formation bombed Grizzana North Viaduct: 12 B-26's dropped 48 x 1000 lb demolition bombs (1/10, .025 second delay fuses) on the target at 1042 hours from 9,300' on an axis of 275° T; 12 B-26's were over Grizzana S Viaduct, and 10 B-26's dropped 4 x 1000 lb demolition bombs (1/10, .025 second delay fuses) and 72 x 500 lb demolition bombs (1/10, .025 second delay fuses) on the target at 1042 hours from 8,700'. 3 B-26's were unable to bomb Vado Viaduct due to malfunction, and dropped 12 x 1000 lb demolition bombs (1/10, .025 second delay fuses) on the second alternate target, Castellare RR bridge, Italy. 16 x 500 lb demolition bombs were returned to base because flight leader was not in position to drop on the target. 3 B-26's returned to base at 1249 hours, and 45 B-26's returned to base late, between 1519 and 1647 hours after landing at Corsica for fuel.

C. RESULTS: On Vado: The target was covered with an excellent concentration of bombs scoring at least one direct hit.

On Grizzana N. Viaduct: An excellent and very tight cluster of bombs landed squarely on the target, scoring 2 direct hits on the center and one at the base of the E end of the viaduct.

On Grizzana S. Viaduct: The target was missed; most of bombs landed over to the W with a few short to the E of the Target.

On Castellare RR Bridge: An excellent concentration of bombs landed on the target, scoring at least 3 direct hits.

D. OBSERVATIONS:

1. Air:

a. Air Activity: 1. Spitfires from Corsica provided escort.

2. One small unidentified silver colored A/C with two tail booms flying NE at 4,000' under formation when formation was flying SW at 1055 hours was seen from 8,000'.

b. Situation:

1. 4 T/E A/C, one on each corner of field, were seen on Siena/Malignano A/D.

2. Castiglion del Lago, Lucca and Forli A/D's not mined.

3. Arezzo and Forli A/D's empty of aircraft.

c. Flak: Scant heavy and light accurate for altitude, inaccurate for deflection on bomb run from Grazzana.  
From Castellare, moderate light inaccurate for altitude and deflection.  
From Vado, scant light and heavy inaccurate for both altitude and deflection.  
2 inaccurate light bursts from landfall just S of Cecina.  
Scant light inaccurate for both altitude and deflection from Pontederra.

d. Shipping:

1. 1 M/V with sunken stern at Q-1128.
2. 1 Med M/V with 5/10 small boats at Viareggio at dock.

3. Losses: None; Damaged, none.

4. Weather:

- a. Enroute: 2-3/10 cumulus at 3,000'; visibility 10 miles in haze.
- b. Target: Clear; visibility 12 miles.
- c. Return: As enroute with increasing cloudiness and showers over Corsica and Sardinia.

E. Routes and Altitudes: From 2,500' at base to rendezvous with escort at Alto; to landfall at Cecina; to Siena; to Palazzo D'Pero; to I.P., Firenzuola, climbing gradually to 10,500'; bomb runs to Grizzana and Vado at 9,500'; breakaway left to Castellare; to Pontederra; (one formation); to Cecina; reciprocal course to base.
