Intelligence Narrative No. 226, Day Operation, 31 May 1944

Flight Commander: Captain Shuh.

A. 320th Bombardment Group (M).

B. At ~~08:05~~ <sup>08:05</sup> hours, 40 B-26's of the 320th Bombardment Group (M) took off to bomb Troop Concentrations East of Albano (M/R#-893479, Sheet 150, CGCS 4164), Italy. 4 spares returned early. 36 B-26's were over the troop concentration and 35 dropped 4,056 x 20# Fragmentation bombs at 09:44 hours from 10,500' to 9,500' on an axis of 11°T. 108 x 20# Fragmentation bombs were salvaged in the target area, having hung up over the target. 6 x 20# Fragmentation bombs were salvaged in the water, having hung up. 126 x 20# Fragmentation bombs were returned to base, having also hung up. 36 B-26's returned to base at 11:11 hours.

C. Results: Heavy smoke obscured the target area, but from photographs showing bombs falling and such visual observation was possible, it appears the one Squadron hit in the West half of the target area, one on the right side with a few out to the East, one in the center of area #4 (annotated photo) and one short of the target area.

D. Observations:

1. Air: None.

2. Ground:

A. General: None.

B. Communications: None.

C. Flak: On bomb run scant heavy inaccurate for altitude, accurate for deflection, continuously pointed fire was encountered.

On breakaway to left, continuing to coast South of Tiber River, moderate heavy accurate for altitude, some accurate and some inaccurate for deflection was encountered. Aircraft that broke right had scant heavy inaccurate from Frascati.

Positions:

6 H -- 4 miles SSW of Ciampino A/D.

4 H -- on road W of Marino.

4 H -- just E of Tiber, 4 miles S of Rome.

4 H -- on S shore of Lake Albano.

4 H -- on highway just N of Lake Albano.

Several 105 mm. bursts were seen.

Flak on the left breakaway was predicted concentration - 1 burst followed by a group of bursts.

3. Losses: None; Damaged, 9; 1 crew member injured.

4. Weather:

a. Enroute: Band of cumulus off coast of Sardinia; high cirrus, base.

B. Target: CAVU with heavy battle haze, smoke and dust.

C. Return: As enroute

D. Routes and Altitudes: From 2,500' at base, to Anzio at 11,500'; to target at 10,500'; breakaway left to coast south of Tiber River (one Squadron); others broke right, away from flak, made 180° curve to right over Vallettri; to base.

E. Comments: This is credited as 2 missions pursuant to recent instructions.
