Intelligence Narrative No. 258, Day Operation, 16 June 1944

Flight Commander: Captain Nunnallee.

A. 320th Bombardment Group (M).

B. At 04:25 hours, 20 B-26's of the 320th Bombardment Group (M) took off to bomb Pisa Main Railroad Bridge, Italy. 20 B-26's were over the target and dropped 80 x 1,000# Demolition bombs (1/10 & .01 second delay fuses) on the target at 06:18 hours from 9,500' to 9,000' on an axis of 70° T. 20 B-26's returned to base at 08:02 hours.

C. Results: The entire structure and approaches were covered with an excellent pattern of bombs. Several direct hits were scored.

D. Observations: See Narrative No. 257.

E. Routes and Altitudes: From base to join up at Ghisonaccia; to landfall at Marina di Pisa; to target; breakaway left; to base.

F. Comments: None.
