Intelligence Narrative No. 292, Day Operation, 27 July 1944

Flight Commander: Captain Hunter.

A. 320th Bombardment Group (M).

B. At 09:30 hours, 19 B-26's of the 320th Bombardment Group (M) took off to bomb the Railroad and Road Bridge at Terrebaretti (M/R: J-776207, sheet 58), Italy. 2 B-26's returned early; 1 spare; 1 engine out out. 17 B-26's were over the target and dropped 68 x 1,000# Demolition bombs (1/10 & .025 second delay fuses) on the target at 12:06 hours from 9,450' to 9,000' on an Axis of 250°. 17 B-26's returned to base at 13:53 hours.

C. Results: The target was covered with an excellent bomb pattern, scoring several direct hits.
