Intelligence Narrative No. 306, Day Operation, 13 August 1944.

Flight Commander: Captain Smith.

A. 320th Bombardment Group (M).

B. At 04:45 hours, 27 B-26's of the 320th Bombardment Group (M) took off to bomb gun position west of Toulon (M/R: (B) Y-798969, sheet 14R), France. No B-26's returned early. 27 B-26's were over the target and 22 B-26's dropped 88 x 1,000# Demolition bombs (1/10 & .025 second delay fuses) on the target at 07:25 hours from 10,000' to 9,500' on an axis of 76°T. 20 x 1,000# Demolition bombs were returned to base, not having been dropped because of poor visibility. 27 B-26's returned to base at 09:06 hours.

C. Results: The target was missed. The bombs landed several hundred yards north of the target in a wooded area. Early-morning shadows and haze prevented identification of the target.
