Intelligence Narrative No. 310, 15 August 1944

Flight Commander: Lt. Col. Macia.

A. 320th Bombardment Group (M).

B. At 04:59 hours, 34 B-26's took off to Bomb Beach in Baie de Cavalaire, West Sector (W/R: (B) U-415066), France. 2 B-26's returned early: 1 loss of power; 1 engine cutting out. 30 B-26's were over the target on two bomb runs and 12 dropped 358 x 100-lb demolition bombs (1/10 nose, non-delay tail fuses) on the target on the first bomb run at 07:04 hours from 8,750 to 8,200' on an axis of 45 degrees. 18 dropped 525 x 100-lb demolition bombs (1/10 nose, non-delay tail fuses) on the target at ^{ON THE SECOND RUN} 07:17 hours from 8,750 feet to 8,200 feet on an axis of 90 degrees; 15 x 100-lb demolition bombs were salvaged in the target area, having hung up over the target. 30 B-26's returned to Base at 08:59 hours.
2 B-26's lost; one crashed on take-off, burned and exploded; crew safe. One hit a mountain shortly after take-off; crashed and exploded; crew lost.

C. Results: The bomb pattern was slightly left to the N. The S. half of the bomb pattern covered the N. edge of the assigned area. Several large red explosions were seen among the bomb bursts.
