Intelligence Narrative No. 315, Day Operation, 18 August 1944

Flight Commander: Captain Rummalee.

A. 320th Bombardment Group (M).

B. At 09:09 hours, 21 B-26's of the 320th Bombardment Group (M) took off to bomb CD Gun Position (M/R; (D) Y-937925, CGCS 4249, sheet 15R) at Toulon, France. 3 B-26's returned early; spares. 18 B-26's were over the target. 9 B-26's dropped 18 x 2,000# Demolition bombs (1/10 & .025 second delay fuses) and 9 B-26's dropped 36 x 1,000# S.A.P. Bombs on the target at 10:56 hours from 10,000' to 11,500' on Axes of 310°T and 315°T. 17 B-26's returned to base at 12:24 hours. 1 B-26 is in Alghero with engine trouble.

C. Results: A good bomb pattern covered the gun position and one to two direct hits are believed to have been scored.
