Intelligence Narrative No. 319, Day Operation, 20 August 1944.

Flight Commander: Lt. Deatly.

A. 320th Bombardment Group (M).

B. At 12:14 hours, 6 B-26's of the 320th Bombardment Group (M) took off to bomb C.D. Gun position at Toulon, J-40 (M/R: (B) Y-901923, GSGS 4249, Sheet 15R), France. 6 B-26's were over the target and 6 B-26's dropped 12 x 2,000# Demolition bombs (1/10 & .025 second delay fuses) on the target at 13:48 hours from 11,900' to 11,400' on an Axis of 330°T. 6 B-26's returned to base at 15:21 hours.

C. Results: An excellent pattern of bombs covered the target area, scoring possible direct hits.

D. Observations:

1. Air:

c. Flak: At Target: M-I, H, FA, FA, Barrage at first CP on breakaway. Commenced 2 minutes before bombs away and continued 4 minutes on the breakaway. Both 88 mm. and 105 mm. reported.

3. Losses: None. Damaged: 1 due to flak.
