Intelligence Narrative No. 336, Day Operation, 5 September 1944

Flight Commander: Captain Munnalle.

A. 320th Bombardment Group (M).

B. At 08:03 hours, 20 B-26's of the 320th Bombardment Group (M) took off to bomb the Road Bridge East of Novara (M/R: (Q) J-990665, GSGS 4164, sheet 44), Italy. 1 B-26 returned early: engine cutting out. 19 B-26's were over the target and 19 B-26's dropped 75 x 1,000# Demolition bombs (1/10 & .025 second delay fuses) on the target at 10:23 hours from 8,600' to 8,100' on an Azis of 360° T. 1 x 1,000# Demolition bombs was returned to base, having hung up over the target. 19 B-26's returned to base at 12:42 hours.

C. Results: An excellent bomb pattern of bombs covered the bridge, scoring several direct hits.
