Intelligence Narrative No. 345, Day Operation, 13 Sept. 1944

Flight Commander: Captain Lunnallee.

A. 320th Bombardment Group (M).

B. At 09:30 hours, 20 B-26's of the 320th Bombardment Group (M) took off to bomb Mt. Oggioli Area, Area #3, Italy. 2 B-26's returned early: 1 spare; 1 engine trouble. 18 B-26's were over the target and dropped 2,694 2,118 x 20-lb. fragmentation bombs on the target at 11:33 hours from 12,100' to 11,500' on an Axis of 0°. 36 x 20-lb. fragmentation bombs, having hung up, were salvaged in the target area. 18 B-26's returned to base at 13:16 hours.

C. Results: There was a good concentration of bombs in the assigned area with some bombs landing short.
