A. 320th Bombardment Group (M).

B. At 08:30 hours, 19 B-26's took off to bomb Defense Position Mt. Oggioli Area, Area NR-1 (M/R) (W) L-871136, GCS 4164, Sheet 98), Italy. No B-26's returned early. 19 B-26's were over the target and 9 B-26's dropped 126 x 250-lb demolition bombs (Instantaneous Nose & .025 second delay tail fuses) and 10 B-26's dropped 1,110 x 20-lb fragmentation bombs on the target at 10:27 hours from 12,200' to 11,700' on an axis of 356 Deg. True. 90 x 20-lb fragmentation bombs were salvaged in the target area, having hung up over the target. 19 B-26's returned to base at 12:15 hours.

C. Results: An excellent pattern covered the entire target area with bomb and fragmentation bomb bursts.

D. Observations

a. Air Activity: P-47's and Spitfires were dive-bombing and strafing gun positions in the target area.

E. Routes: Base to mouth of Ombrone River; to Siena; to Is. San Pietro A Sieve; to target; break right to Marradi; to Siena; to mouth of Ombrone River; to Base.
