Intelligence Narrative No. 372, Day Operation, 12 Oct., 1944

A. 320th Bombardment Group (M).

B. At 14:37 hours, 24 B-26's of the 320th Bombardment Group (M) took off to bomb Fuel Dump South-West of Bologna (M/R: (W) L-835455, GSGS 4164, Sheet 87), Italy. 2 spares returned early. 22 B-26's were over the target. No bombs were dropped on the target due to cloud cover. The formation was over the target at 16:38 hours from 11,000' to 10,000' on an Axis of 103°T. 14 x 250# Demolition bombs were salvaged in the water on return, due to engine trouble. All other bombs were returned to base. 22 B-26's returned to base at 17:50 hours.
