Intelligence Narrative No. 376, Day Operation, 15 Oct., 1944

Flight Commander: Captain Rowan.  
Lead Pilot: Captain Barge.

A. 320th Bombardment Group (M).

B. At 08:15 hours, 20 B-26's of the 320th Bombardment Group (M) took off to bomb Cassengo Railroad Fill (W/R: (R) F-589795, GCS 4164, sheet 48), Italy. 2 B-26's returned early: Spares. 18 B-26's were over the target and 18 B-26's dropped 144 x 500# Demolition bombs (1/10 & .025 second delay fuses) on the target at 09:54 hours from 10,550' to 10,000' on an Az of 36°T. 18 B-26's returned to base at 11:03 hours.

C. Results: An excellent concentration of bombs covered the target area, and several direct hits were scored on the fill, and the 10th to 30th cars of a 40 car train moving North over the fill, and possibly on the locomotive of a second train. Some bombs started short and walked into the target area.

D. Observations:

1. Air:

- a. Air Activity: None.
- b. Situation: Ghedi and Fidenza A/D's empty of aircraft.

2. Ground:

a. General:

- (1) All bridges between Moneglia and Fidenza appeared serviceable.
- (2) Bridge up at Peschiera.
- (3) Fire and smoke on East edge of La Spezia.

b. Communications:

- (1) 50 RR cars at Borgo Val Di Taro.
- (2) 40 RR cars at Moneglia.
- (3) 150 RR cars at Fidenza.
- (4) Train of 15/20 cars headed South into Fidenza at 09:36 hours.
- (5) Supply dump West of Bozzole.
- (6) 75 RR cars at Carpendalea.
- (7) 20 M/T headed North-West from Guidizzolo at 09:38 hours.
- (8) Train of 30 cars, stationary, at Ghedi at 09:38 hours.
- (9) 1 large white trailer-truck moving North from Goite at 09:38 hours.
- (10) 50/75 RR cars at Peschiera.
- (11) 9 M/T moving South into Peschiera at 09:42 hours.
- (12) Train of 30 cars headed East at Lonato at 09:39 hours.
- (13) 150 RR cars at Desenzano.
- (14) Train of 30 RR cars headed South toward Verona at 10:07 hours.
- (15) 50 RR cars at Ala.
- (16) 50 RR cars at Mori.

c. Flak: None.

d. Shipping:

- (1) 1 large M/V at Sestri Levante at 09:15 hours.
- (2) 1 large boat and 2 tugs at La Spezia, at 09:14 hours.
- (3) Several small boats in Lake Garda.

3. Losses: None. Damaged: None.

4. Weather:

- a. Horizon: Band of cumulus, tops 8,000', over sea and mountains. Overcast at 1,000' in Southern Po Valley.
- b. Target Vicinity: Scattered cumulus over mountains, tops 11,000' and higher. Valley clear.
- c. Target: Clear.
- d. Return: Stratus breaking up in Po Valley. Cumulus tops over sea building to 12-13,000'.

5. Routes: Base to Moneglia; to Fidenza; to I.P., Asola; to target on an Azis of 36°T; breakaway left to Asola; to Moneglia; to base.
