320th Bombardment Group (M).

NOVELATO-PIAVE AB BRIDGE (S/R) A-696035, COORD 4104, Sheet 36, Italy.

At 10:40 hours, 20 B-26's took off. 2 B-26's returned early: 1 congealed oil; 1 spare. No B-26's lost prior to the target. 18 B-26's were over the target. 16 B-26's dropped 66 x 1,000# Demolition bombs (1/10, nose & non-delay fuses) and 5 x 1,000# Demolition bombs (6-hour delay fuses) on the primary target at 12:00 hours from 11,000' to 10,000' on an Axis of 33° T. 1 x 1,000# demolition bomb (1/10, nose & non-delay fuses) was salvoed over water, having hung up over the target. No bombs were returned to base. 16 B-26's returned to base at 13:11 hours. No B-26's lost or missing. 3 B-26's slightly damaged by flak. No B-26's seriously damaged.

RESULTS: An excellent pattern of bombs covered the target, scoring several direct hits. The bombs of one Squadron landed south-east of the target, missing it.

ENEMY FIGHTER OBSERVATION: None.

FLAK: S, H, FA, L, ~ G type flak was encountered from Rovereto, A-6903. Encountered from 30 seconds before bombs away until 60 seconds into breakaway. 8 H guns at A-6802. S, L, I, I, flak encountered from P-6693.

ROUTE: Base to Ineglia, P-4020; to Fidenza, P-9094; to L. Malo, P-2974; to target on an Axis of 33° T; breakaway left to Lezzenzano, U-3050; to Fidenza, P-9094; reciprocal course to base.

WEATHER:

- a. Airspace: Over water, scattered cumulus at 6,000'; generally CAVU in Po Valley and over Apennines.
- b. Vicinity of target: Few scattered alto-cumulus, increasing to the North.
- c. Target area: Open.
- d. Nature: As enroute.

AIR OBSERVATIONS:

- a. Air activity:
 - (1) 12 unidentified $\sqrt{5}$ a/c flying west at 12,000' over Fidenza, P-9094, were seen at 12:35 hours.
 - (2) 6 unidentified $\sqrt{5}$ a/c flying North, South of Lezzenzano, U-3050, at 12:23 hours.

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b. Situation: 2 large white crosses on Ghedi A/D, P-0957, at 12:22 hours.

NAVAL OBSERVATIONS: None.

- (4) 10 M/T moving West at P-1223 at 11:52 hours.
- (5) 6 M/T moving South at P-1534 at 11:52 hours.
- (6) 10 M/T moving East at K-9826 at 11:52 hours.
- (7) 45 MM cars including 3 extra long repair cars at P-2359 at 11:58 hours.
- (8) 5 groups of 2/5 M/T moving in both directions in the vicinity of Salo, P-2974 at 12:00 hours.
