320th Bombardment Group (M).

AVISIO RAILROAD VIADUCT (M/R: (R) A-747304, GSGS 4164, Sheet 21), Italy.  
ALTERNATE: PIACENTONE RAILROAD BRIDGE (M/R: (C) K-689301, GSGS 4164, Sheet 60),  
Italy.

At 09:05 hours, 40 B-26's took off. 6 B-26's returned early: 3 spares; 1 loose trim-tabs; 1 engine cutting out; 1 chute opened in a/c. No B-26's lost prior to the target, and alternate target. 34 B-26's were over the target. 34 B-26's dropped 119 x 1,000# Demolition bombs (1/10 & .01 second delay fuses) and 12 x 1,000# Demolition bombs (6-hour delay fuses) on the Alternate target at 12:21 hours from 10,200' to 9,200' on an Axis of 169°T. The Primary target was obscured by a effective smoke screen and the Alternate was bombed instead. 5 x 1,000# Demolition bombs (1/10 & .01 second delay fuses) were salvaged: 4 because of bomb bay doors malfunction in the vicinity of the target, and 1 in the water on the return, having hung up over the target. No bombs were returned to base. 33 B-26's returned to base at 13:18 hours. 1 B-26 returned to base at 14:43 hours, after landing at Pisa A/D for gas. No B-26's lost or missing. 2 B-26's slightly damaged by flak. No B-26's seriously damaged.

RESULTS: An excellent pattern covered the Alternate target, scoring 4/5 direct hits.

ENEMY FIGHTER OPPOSITION: None.

FLAK: S, H, A, 1 -GP type flak encountered from A/D South of Bergamo, K-6580. Long deflection shots, a total of 23/30 bursts. 4 H guns at South-West corner of A/D.

ROUTE: Base to Rimini, K-8698; to south of Piave River, K-0163; to Sacile, B-8507; to Acordo, B-4945; to Predazzo, B-1649; to L. Cavalese, B-0347; to Canes, A-9240; to Mezzolombardo, A-7740; to A-6040; to F-3092; to Sarnico, K-8683; to Romano, A-6968; to IP, 2 miles East of Crema, K-6650; to Alternate target on an Axis of 169°T; breakaway left; curve right to Fiorenzuola; K-7501; to Monzilia, P-4028; to base.

- Vicinity of Target: Clear with haze.
- Target Area: Clear with haze.
- Return: As enroute.
