SPAYER RR AND ROAD BRIDGE, GERMANY (M/R: (W) R-521801, GSSS 4416, Sheet U-3).

320th Bombardment Group (M).

51 B-26's took off at 1237 hours to bomb Spayer RR and Road Bridge, Germany. 5 B-26's returned early; Engines cutting out. Total Sorties: 46. No B-26's were over the primary target for reason stated on Report #2, this date. 46 B-26's were over the alternate target and 46 dropped 1 84 x 1,000-lb demolition bombs (.1. non-delay fuses) on the alternate target, Mastatt RR Bridge, (M/R: (W) R-251267, GSSS 4416, Sheet U-2), at 14:59 hours from 18,400' to 10,400' on an axis of 80 Deg. True (Briefed axis, 82 Deg. True; Drift correction over IP, -5 Deg. Right; Evasive action at IP, loss of 1,400' and slow turns to bomb run). No bombs were salvaged or returned to base. No B-26's lost or missing. 2 B-26's damaged, Cat. II by flak; 2 B-26's damaged, Cat. I by flak. 46 B-26's returned to base at 15:59 hours.

FLAK: S, H, I, I. GP Type flak encountered from Lauterberg-Wissenbourg Areas (W) R-2040, after the breakaway only. Flak was generally inaccurate, but was fairly accurate for the third Squadron (of 6 Squadrons).

M, L, I, I. Type flak was encountered from target vicinity on Bomb Run.

LOSSES TO FLAK: None. DAMAGED BY FLAK: 4.

RESULTS: The bombs of one squadron landed on the south end of the bridge possibly hitting it and approaches. Other bombs landed short, north and south of the target. One cluster of bombs started in the town, walking to the M/Y, causing large explosion with black smoke.
