GUN POSITIONS NEAR LABACH (W/R: (H) Q-391369, GCS 4416, Sheet V-1), Germany.

At 11:42 hours, 3 B-26's took off to bomb Gun Positions near Labach (W/R: (H) Q-391369, GCS 4416, Sheet V-1), Germany, and acting as a decoy for the main formation. No B-26's returned early. Total sorties: 3. No B-26's were over the target and no B-26's dropped Fragmentation bombs. Formation turned back at Volklingen, Q-3573, at 13:55 hours from 12,000', because of bad weather. No bombs were salvaged. All bombs were returned to base. No B-26's lost or missing. No B-26's damaged. 3 B-26's returned to base at 13:06 hours.
