OFFENBURG M/Y, Area "D", (M/R: (W) W-160875, GSGS 4416, sheet W-2), Germany.

At 12:06 hours, 56 B-26's took off to bomb Offenburg M/Y, Area "D", (M/R: (W) W-160875, GSGS 4416, sheet W-2), Germany. 2 B-26's returned early: 1 engine trouble; 1 prop trouble. Total sorties: 54. 54 B-26's were over the target and 48 B-26's dropped 304 x 500-lb. Demolition bombs (.1 & .01 second delay fuses) and 80 x 500-lb. M17 incendiary clusters with M-138 fuse set at 19 seconds on the target at 14:00 hours from 12,300' to 11,200' on an Azis of 77°T. 8 x 500-lb. Demolition bombs were salvoed, due to loss of power at 13:59 hours at the target area. 40 x 500-lb. Demolition bombs were returned to base, due to bombardier error of Squadron lead A/C. No B-26's lost or missing. 21 B-26's damaged by flak, Category I; 2 B-26's damaged by flak, Category II. 53 B-26's returned to base at 15:05 hours. 1 B-26 landed at Lunville at 14:30 hours, due to oil leak.
