Primary was not bombed due to weather and 6 B-26's were over a target of opportunity, St. Georgen M/Y (M/R: (R) W-455475), and 6 B-26's dropped 42 x 500-lb. Demolition bombs (.1 & .025 second delay tail fuses) and 6 x 500-lb. Demolition bombs (6 hour and 12 hour delay fuses minus anti-removal device) at 13:31 hours from 10,500' on an axis of 35°T.
