AMMUNITION DUMP AT (M/R; (W) Q-598765, GSGS 4416, Sheet U-1), Germany.

At 08:15 hours, 54 B-26's took off to bomb Ammunition Dump at (M/R; (W) Q-598765, GSGS 4416, Sheet U-1), Germany. 4 B-26's returned early: Engineering. Total Sorties: 50. No B-26's were over the Primary target and No B-26's dropped any bombs, due to weather at the Primary and Alternate targets, and the formation returned at the OP, L-5509, at 10:25 hours from 13,500' to 12,500'. No Bombs were salvaged. All bombs were returned to base. No B-26's lost or missing. No B-26's damaged. 50 B-26's returned to base at 12:13 hours.

- a. Enroute : 90 miles North of Dijon thin cumulus at 5,000', increasing in coverage to the North, with top deck of increasing altitude.
- b. Vicinity of Target: 9/10ths cumulus, tops 10,000', with a few isolated breaks.
- c. Target Area : 10/10ths cumulus, tops, 10,000', over Primary and Alternate targets.
- d. Return : Generally the same as enroute, but with cloud coverage increasing in the Dijon area.
